The Full Day Kindergarten Program

District 202 will offer one full day kindergarten session for each elementary school.

We may not have room in each elementary school for the classrooms, so some classes may be located in a neighboring school. Students attending a neighboring school will return to their home school for first grade.

District 202 decided to offer a pilot Full Day Kindergarten program because:

1. We have not had - and still do not have -- adequate classroom space for a full kindergarten program for all students. This is the second year we have had sufficient space to offer one full day kindergarten classroom for each of our elementary schools.
2. District 202 cannot afford a complete Full Day Kindergarten program.
3. It's better to start now with a pilot program than continue to wait until we have space and money. Our community told us years ago that Full Day Kindergarten is a top priority. We agree!

Full Kindergarten Day Hours

All Elementary Schools, except Lakewood Falls-9:05-3:40.
Lakewood Falls- 8:55-3:30.

Age Requirement

Per State Law, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2019 to enroll in kindergarten.

Lottery Process

- Families will register each child for the lottery online at on the District 202 web site and all 17 elementary school web sites.
- Students will be selected by a computerized random drawing.
- Families of selected children will receive information about the Kindergarten registration process and must pay the first month's tuition to ensure their child's slot.
- Families of children who are not selected, will receive information about the wait list process.

Lottery/Registration Timeline for 2019-2020

- January 28, 2019, 7 a.m. to February 8, 2019, 5 p.m. - Lottery Window for the Lottery
- February 15th, 2019 - Lottery drawing at 10 a.m. All families notified of the Lottery results, with appropriate instructions for "next steps."
- April 5th, 2019 3 p.m. - Kindergarten registration completed and first month's tuition due for children selected for Full Day Kindergarten.
- Families who do not register by the deadline will lose their full day kindergarten slot and move to the bottom of the wait list.

Residency Requirements

All families must reside within Plainfield Community Consolidated School District 202 attendance boundaries for their children to attend the assigned school.

Tuition and Fees

A \$100 nonrefundable deposit is due at the time of registration (by April 5, 2019). This will cover the first month's tuition.

Monthly tuition is \$100. The monthly tuition is in addition to the regular \$90 annual kindergarten registration fee. The \$100 monthly tuition will help offset the cost of the extra staff and resources needed to offer this program.

The yearly tuition is divided into nine equal payments. Payment is due on the first of the month. The non-refundable \$100 deposit will constitute first tuition payment, and completes the payment for September. The remaining eight installments are due the first school day of the month, September through April. Families will receive a tuition payment schedule upon completion of registration.

A late fee of \$25 will be charged for payments not received on the first calendar day of each month. There is no tuition reduction due to illness, absences or the days school is closed. Families who carry an overdue balance without timely payment will be dropped from the tuition program.

Families must have no outstanding balance from the tuition preschool program by August 1, 2019 or their child will be dropped from the full day kindergarten program. Families are encouraged to pay tuition online.
